# **Trapped**

New York City: Friday October 31, 1999, 11PM

Nicholas White is working late on an urgent assignment. The 34 year-old manager is in a large open-plan office on the 43rd floor of a New York building. On the other side of the room a solitary co-worker is on the phone.

Nick walks out of the office, leaving his coat on his chair. He takes elevator down to the lobby. Walking into the cool autumn night, he lights up a cigarette.

When Nick returns to the lobby it is very quiet. There is nobody around. The building is empty.

Nick gets into the express elevator. He presses the button for the 43rd floor.

The elevator accelerates up through the floors. There are no stops before the 39th floor, but everything seems fine.

Suddenly the elevator stops. The lights flash off and then on again. At this moment, Nick's co-worker is leaving the office. He gets into the down elevator. He is unaware that Nick is trapped somewhere below the 39th floor

In the other elevator, Nick presses the alarm. He sits down and waits for someone to come and rescue him

But nobody comes because nobody is there. The maintenance staff have gone home for the weekend. Nick is now alone in the building


Ten minutes tick by. Nick takes out his phone - but of course there's no signal! But he can see that a security camera on. Surely someone will see him soon.
